These 24 hours come with strong ^{Breeze} S E head
steering N. W. 6 P.M. put 2 reefs in the
main sail Middle and latter part thick
and squally. Lett by Tied up at 2 P.M. 38 53
Long 76 53

Friday Oct 26th

These 24 hours come with strong breezes
E. S. E steering N. W. 4 P.M. more more
wind S. S. E under all sail 4 sails in sight
at 6 strong breezes sounder 31 fath at 8 wind
N. S. W steering N. W. by 8 strong breezes at
11 00 P.M. saw Montez Light bearing N. by E
at 1 P.M. steering for Bl. S. & E. A.M. still
for the mouth of Buzzard bay At 2 P.M.
lett go anchor in Sippican Harbor
So ends this voyage

at 6 P.M. in the P. edge
the 3 Stream water 63
