

Wednesday Oct 31st

This day came with moderate trades from E. at 8.30 a.m. captain went ashore at 1 P.M. captain returned with all hands making 14. portugees from brass and all hands 34. set all sail and stered S.W. got some cits

Thursday Nov 1st

This day came in with a fresh breeze from N. steering S.W. under all sail at 3 P.M. took in royal flying jib at 7 P.M. took in top gallant sail and stands Broke out beef & water - no ends

Friday Nov 2^d

This day heavy and nasty weather wind E. Brig heading S.W. by the wind Rove off new upper top gal brace & fore steeple halysard & down hall new jib hallards gave the men some oil skins - no ends

Saturday Nov 3^d

This day came and lite air from the S.W. Brig heading S.W. under all sail Broke out and gave clothing to the men forward saw a steamer and 2 sails spoke and went on board of a ship called the F. Nile of Glasgow England they being short of food gave them 3 lbs of hard bread and a lb of flour stored off the boat and cleared up deck 7 P.M. rainy - no ends

Sunday Nov 4th

This day lite air from N. and rainy saw a steamer going N. brig heading S.W. under all sail 7 P.M. came and lite air

Monday Nov 5th

This day came in with lite air and heavy from E. first part of the day employed in setting up head stays and copers at 4 P.M. raised a lone whale going to the N. got our boats ready and lowered did not see him again no chance at all 7 P.M. thick and steadily under all sail steering to the S.W. no ends

Tuesday Nov 6th

This day came in with a moderate breeze from the N.W. all sail set steering S.W. employed in ships duty saw 3 sails one man sick with fever

Wednesday Nov 7th

This day came in with lite wind from the E. Brig heading S.W. under all sail employed in overhauling foot ropes on the yard and doing other odd jobs saw several sails bound S. John Durant sick with several drea - no ends

Thursday Nov 8th

This day lite breeze from S.W. all sail set heading S by the wind employed in finishing up the foot ropes and cutting over carbe 2 sails in cits
