Saturday Nov 10th

This day came in with a moderate breeze from the S. brig heading to the S & W under all sail all hands employed in doing ship duty saw a sail & steamer

Sunday Nov 11th

This day came in with a moderate breeze from S. all sail set steering to the S & W saw a school of Porpoises lat 1-6

Monday Nov 12th

This day came in with fresh trades from S. all sail set steering by the wind brig heading S & W by S employed in getting spade ready for whaling and doing other odd jobs about deck 7 P.M. took in the fore topgallant sail got a porpoise

Tuesday Nov 13th

This day came in with lite trades from S. at 4 a.m. Mr. Foster went and tried to set the fore topgallant sail and carried away the yard on account of not letting go his braces employed all day sending yard & sail down and getting out steps to fix it with repaired the topgallant sail saw a sch going S.
so ends

Wednesday Nov 14th

This day came in with moderate trades from the S. brig heading S by W under all sail employed in fishing the topgallant yard and doing other ship duty - so ends -

Thursday Nov 15th

This day lite air from S. brig heading S by the wind employed in fishing the topgallant yard 8 P.M. wind lite so ends

Friday Nov 16th

This day came in with strong trades from S. brig heading by the wind under easy sail 8 a.m. sent up the topgallant yard and bent the sail broke out the hole for water - so ends -

Saturday Nov 17th

This day came in with a moderate breeze from the S. brig heading S & W by the wind employed all day breaking out water saw a white water on the lee bow

Sunday Nov 18th

This day came in with moderate breeze from S. all sail set steering by the wind brig heading S & W at 8 a.m. took in flying jib and set up the stay as well as the jib topsail and bumper stay 12 o'clock made all sail again - so ends -
