

Tuesday June 4th

This day moderate at 7.30 a.m.
cleared up around deck bent the
mainmast fluted the boats hove up
our anchor and made sail
secured the anchor stowed our
chain below 7. P.M. steering along
the land under easy sail
2 men sick

Wednesday June 5th

This day a moderate breeze
from N.W. brig heading
to S.E. by the wind
scrapping and cleaning
up around decks under
moderate sail 4 sick

Thursday June 6th

This day ruff and windy ship
heading to S.E. on port tack
and N.W. by N on starboard tack
8 P.M. half a gale from N.E.
standing to the eastward
under very short sail
7 men sick forward

Friday June 7th

This day a fresh breeze from
N.W. brig heading N.E.
under easy sail 6 men on
sick list

Saturday June 8th

This day wind N.W. brig heading N.
under easy sail with ruff
8 on the tired list

Sunday June 9th

This day fresh breeze from
N.W. steering N. under
easy sail brig leaking
forward 7 men laid up
Walker fainting on deck

Monday June 10th

This a fresh breeze wind
N.W. under moderate sail
brig heading N. by the
wind took an hour and
a half to pump ship
Broke out 8 bags of bread
