Saturday July 27th

This day fine weather wind W standing SSW part of the day and N. the other half. Under all sail saw a steamer bound to the SW. employed in ships duty. 8 men sick

Sunday July 28th

This day came in with a calm 3 P.M. light breeze from S. all square sails set steering NW by W 1/2 W doing nothing 7 men on sick list

Monday July 29th

This day came in with light air and came from different points all sail set steering W. or W. wind at 8 P.M. SW employed in ships duty. 7 men on sick list. - captain found some of the goods out the after run gone

Tuesday July 30th

This day fine and light air from NW at 1 P.M. made all sail steering W or W employed in cleaning and doing other ships duty & before

Wednesday July 31st

This day came in with the wind N and blowing fresh in sail at 4 P.M. laying under 2. steeple top sail and 3 reefed main sail 9 men sick

Thursday Aug 1st

This day came in with the wind to the W. blowing and usually home too under easy sail 7.30 a.m. wore ship to the N. shifting over the main steeple the tail rope parted and our sheet and the sail blew to pieces around the clew 9 men laid up

Friday Aug 2d

This day first part windy & ruff wind W. at 11 a.m. moderated down set fore and aft 4 P.M. saw the land somewhere around the cape of good Hope wore ship to the SSW. Broke out water made a foremast steeple 10 men laid up

Saturday Aug 3d

This day wind NW under short sail brig heading or employed in ships duty & before 8 men sick or tired

Sunday Aug 4th

This day came with light air from or 9 a.m. made all sail at 3 P.M. took in fore top allant sail main topmast steeple put 2 reefs in main sail at 4.30 P.M. fresh breeze 7 men on sick list
