7 men on sick list sundry cures

Tuesday Aug 6th

This day light air and calm at 2.30 PM wind SW steering NW by N under all sail employed in ships duty at different things 5 men on sick list
Broke out water

Wednesday Aug 7th

This day a moderate Breeze from the N & W all sail set steering to the N 2 pm saw the land at 2.30 P.M. lashed ship to the western wind hauled N & W employed in ships duty
6 men sick

Thursday Aug 8th

This day fine weather passed the point of Cape of Good Hope broke out and bent the outer jib and sent the Royal yard aloft 7 men sick

Friday Aug 9th

This day fine weather wind S. brig heading N by W under square sails bent fore royal & old lower topsail repaired the new one and bent the old fore topmast stacal
5 men laid up

Saturday Aug 10th

This day fine weather light air from S. all square sails set steering N by W employed in repairing the fore & gallant sail 5 men on sick list
Broke out but no water

Sunday Aug 11th

This day fine weather wind S. steering N by W finished repairing the fore & gallant sail 5 men sick Mr Lawrence would not see on the sail unless called

Monday Aug 12th

This day fine weather a moderate Breeze from S. steering N by W & W employed in setting up the bob chain and fibrous guys 5 men sick and others complaining in fact a sick crowd all through

Tuesday Aug 13th

This day moderate breeze from SW all sail set steering N by W employed in knocking down casks and building a pen between decks for sails and cutting gear
5 men sick
