This day employed in shifting cutting gear and unhooked the 3. cornered manual and bent the old manual and doing other ship duty 5 men on sick list - wind S.W. steering N.W. by N. 1/2 N.

Thursday Aug 15th

This day fine weather wind S. steering N.W. by N. 1/2 N. under square sails employed in scraping and cofoorth sent up the gaff topsail 5 men sick

Friday Aug 16th

This day wind S. steering N.W. under all square sails employed in scraping mast booms and cofoorth 3 men on sick list

Saturday Aug 17th

This day fine weather wind S. steering N.W. under all square sails employed in scraping masts & cofoorth 3 men sick broke out beef

Sunday Aug 18th

This day wind lite from S. & S.W. square sails outter fib and 3. stacole set steering N.W. Mr. Lawrence refused to interpret for the cap 5 men laid up

Monday Aug 19th

This day moderate breeze from S.W. all square sails set steering N.W. employed in washing off the ship 5 men sick

Tuesday Aug 20th

This day lite air from S. steering N. by W. 1/2 W. employed in cleaning ship 5 men on sick list - captain home a dog over board

Wednesday Aug 21st

This day fine weather and lite air from S. employed in scraping and doing general ships work 4 men on sick list steering N. by W. 1/2 W. under square sails

Thursday Aug 22^d

This day lite trader all sail set steering N.W. by W. employed in ships duty painting coal tarring and scraping dead eyes 3 men on sick list

Friday Aug 23^d

This day lite air and calm steering N.W. at 7 a.m. raised the island of St. Helens distance 20 miles hauled up and put our cable all ready to let go 3 men sick sundown calm island bearing N.W. distance 10 miles
