This day first part calm at 8 a.m. breezed up from N.W. all sail set. Steering and beating along the land 2 boats came off from shore at Beating all day got within 2 miles of harbor and at 5.45 tacked off shore for the night 2 men sick

Sunday Aug 25th

This day calm all day laying off to the N of St. Helena distance 9 miles 2 boats came alongside at 3 P.M. 2 men sick

Monday Aug 26th

This day calm again working into the land boat came off with the harbor master and we got our letters 2 men sick

Tuesday Aug 27th

This day calm beating along the land not much doing 2 men sick

Wednesday Aug 28th

This day a moderate breeze from SW at 5.30 a.m. came to anchor in Jamestown St. Helena after breakfast started breaking out and setting up casks got some water from water boat to hospital - one whaley 2 men went

Thursday Aug 29th

This day laying at anchor in St. Helena employed in painting ship stowing oil and setting up Shooka crew on shore at liberty

Friday Aug 30th

This day employed in painting and stowing ship and setting up shooka 2 men deserted Drinkerwater & Gardner otherwise things going well crew on shore at liberty Cooper struck fog with a stone

Saturday Aug 31st

This day laying at anchor employed in setting up casks stowing the hold and getting water to painting ship 6 P.M. crew on shore on liberty

Sunday Sep 1st

This day laying at anchor crew on shore at liberty

Monday Sep 2^d

This day laying at anchor finished stowing down at 2 P.M. let starboard watch ashore ~~captain~~ Cooper aboard drink left 2 men in hospital and 2 run away 4 P.M. all ready for sea Cooper making lots of trouble, received some goods from shore captain aboard at 5.30 P.M.
