

Friday Nov 1st

This day came in with the wind to the Eastward under moderate sail steering N or NW at daylight saw 4 small whales going to windward. Quack hauled aback but no chance so kept off N or NW again at 3.30 P.M. Saw some more got boats ready and lowered 3 boats but never seen them out of the boats so came aboard at dark with a wet sea and hungry gut shorted down for the night for Dias Silvia still sick

Saturday Nov 2^d

This day came in with the wind from the SW Brig steering N or NW under moderate sail at 4 P.M. got in green water N. of the stream for Dias Silvia still off duty Mr Jasper turned to

Sunday Nov 3^d

This day wind to the Westward Brig heading to the N under easy sail saw 3 sailing vessels & 3 steamers for Silvia sick

Monday Nov 4th

This day came in with light air and calm wind N or NW Brig heading to the N saw one steamer for Silvia sick

Tuesday Nov 5th

This day wind SW light all sail set steering N at 12 or noon raised a school of whales lowered 3 boats mate struck foul line whale capsize the boat and took his line and whales went out to windward boat came aboard at 5.30 P.M. made sail and kept off N by 6 under all sail for Dias Silvia still sick

Wednesday Nov 6th

This day wind to the Eastward and raining hard Brig heading about N at 1 P.M. raised a 4 master ahead lowered a boat and went alongside got some rigging and his long which gave us block island bearing N. 3/4 N distance 110 miles for Dias Silvia Jerome & St. Barbara laid up
