Sept 29.

Brig Daisy laying at anchor  
Monday 29

This day light  
Easterly weather with fog and moderate  
rain. 2 two boats after Elephant at 9.30  
A.M. started to boil up dark all  
hands on board. very light air with  
the barometer very low just below 29.

Tues 30. This day begins  
with very light weather. began running down  
some of the oil. also minding at 4 P.M. the  
wind breezes up sharp from the S.W. at  
dark we have run down 19. Cask also  
gave the ship some more chain. we have  
eleven more cask of oil on deck.

Wed 30. This day begins with  
moderate weather began stowing the remainder  
of the oil. at 9.30 A.M. began to boil again  
at 2 o'clock a thick snow storm set in. so  
had to cool the works down. got the oil all  
below at 3 o'clock the wind came  
on from the S.W. and so ends the day  
with 4 cask of hot oil on deck.  
See lots of ice bergs drifting down by the ship.

Oct 1st Thursday 1st begins & ends with  
very fine weather. wind very light  
2 two boats on shore after Elephant  
at 3.30 P.M. sent one boat to help the  
2 two boats tow a raft of blubber. at  
7 P.M. all the boats on board. with  
a long raft of blubber.

To the Island of South Georgia

Oct 2 1900

Friday 2 This day begins with  
moderate winds from the East with rain &  
snow. at 10 ten A.M. the wind changed to  
the N.W. at 12 o'clock began to clear and  
wind more to the West. latter part quite good  
weather wind fresh all hands on board minding

Sat 3.

This day begins with fine  
weather began to boil also sent 2 two boats  
after Elephant. it soon began to breeze on  
strong from the S.W. at dark still fresh winds boats  
on board with good loads of blubber.

Sunday 4 To day begins with very  
heavy S.W. wind. at 9.30 A.M. the moderated  
breeze began to boil. all hands on board

Monday 5. This day very heavy  
wind squalls at times stowed oil below  
sent one boat after Elephant. also boiled  
at 11 o'clock moderate.

Tues 6. This day begins with very  
heavy winds from the South West began pumping  
water preparatory to stowing down all middle  
oil. after still blowing very hard run down  
70. bbls oil. all hands on board ship laying  
with 3 three anchors down and a long scope of chain.

Wed 7. To day begins & ends with  
very light Easterly weather. the boats after  
Elephant also stowing down oil. at dark  
all hands on board. " " " " " "
