Brig Daisy of New Bedford

Sunday 18. This day begins with very heavy winds from the west all hands on board latter part stowed down Oil. See 2 two steamers pass in and come to anchor.

Monday 19. This day begins with strong winds from the west also light snow sent 1 one boat after Elephant see 2 two steamers pass by. Latter part very moderate.

Tues 20. This day begins with fine weather wind from the west began and boxed all day 2 two boats on shore after blubber. = " at dark the 2 two boats returned with good loads and a raft. = "

Wed 21. This day begins and ends with very light wind from the west and snow 2 two boats after Elephant. = " at dark clear. = no ends

Thurs 22. This day begins with strong winds from the W. west boxed the small amount of blubber we had minced also stowed down Oil. 1 one boat after Elephant. Latter part still strong winds.

Friday 23. This day the weather has been very good 3 three boats after Elephant.

Sat 24. This day begins with very fine weather wind Right from the East 3 three boats after Elephant. at 7 PM on the boat on board with good loads and raft.

Sunday 25. This day begins with moderate Easterly wind at 9 AM wind breezed on quite fresh all hands on board mincing to end the day.

Monday 26. This day begins with Easterly wind quite strong all hands on board mincing and boiling at dark 13 cask full of Oil so ends the day. = "

Tues 27. This day begins with moderate wind from the East 1 boat after Elephant at noon sent the second boat 2 PM sent the third boat also boxed the small lot of blubber we had on deck at night we have 13 cask of Oil on deck. all the boats on board with blubber.

Wed 28. This day begins with very weather 1 one boat after Elephant. also storing down Oil so ends the day.

Thurs 29. This day begins with Easterly wind at 7 AM began to freeze on also a thick snow storm. at 11.30 began to get good weather so the last 1/2 day the weather was fine and the wind got around to the N. West. so ends the day.
