

Nov 19th 1908

Box 19th 14089 Ring Daisy Laying at the Island

Thurs 19. This day began with very light winds also light fog at ^{one} o'clock got the ship under weigh and started for Passacon Bay. got down abreast of island and began to beat the ship up to the anchorage dark came on so could not see very well let the anchor go from the bows the chain got foul so by the time it took to clear the chain the ship drifted off of the hawse into deep water. where the anchor could not reach bottom. we then tried to heave the anchor up again worked all night then the ship drifted in where the anchor got a hold of the bottom. then furled the sails and let the men go below. a while a very hard night of it for all hands in tacking the ship around she just touches on the bottom but slides right off. very easy.

Friday 20 This day begins with moderate wind, but soon began to blow on from the W. & the ship dragged her anchor some. blowed heavy in squalls at night began to moderate some but decided to drop the second anchor, for safety of the ship. then set the wack " " "

a boat and went up to sound the harbor
out. latter part - Capt. returned bringing
a lot of Silver bottom bones in his boat.

2..1908 Sunday 22.. This day begins with moderate S.W. winds how the starboard anchor up to the Cathead.. after dinner 2 tug boats went up the bay and got 2 two loads of bone from the light suffer bottoms that lay on the beach, also mined Valubber on the ship..

Monday 23. Today begins and ends with very light & misty air. Got the ship under weigh and took boat ahead to town and help sail the ship at 10 AM got the ship up inside of the Pass. near to the small islands and anchored here in eight fathoms of water. Then sent a raft of Cask on shore also 1 one boat after Elephant. so ends the day.

Thurs 24 The day begins with Calons
2 Twa boats after elephant platter wind S. & heat
with rain so ends the day " " " "

Wed 24. This day begins with
westerly gales, and two boats, the Elephant
also trailing the old blubber we had
latter part Calm. " " " " " " " "

Thurs²⁶ This day begins with moderate North winds also rain & two boats after Elephant all 10 men pleased some no stored down for hills & oil latter part wind cold fresh

Thursday 27. Bo day begins and ends with very light weather. Three boats after Elephant.
