March 4 This day we have had light Easterly winds. Ship on the Starboard tack. See 1 on sail
Leat 23.17 South
Long 32.44 West

March 5 This day the weather had been very fine calm all day ship laying with everything clewed up. Leat 23.29
Long 32.22 W

March 6 This day begins ends with very moderate winds from the North ship on the port tack. The watch busy at ship duty.
Leat 23.09 S
Long 32.56 W

Sunday 7. This day moderate breeze from the N.E. East
Leat 22.37 S
Long 31.30 W

Monday 8 This day the wind is still from the N.E. East. See 2 sails to day trying to get to the north
Leat 22.31 S
Long 31.48 W

March 9 This day begins with very light winds from the East. Ship steering N.W. East at 10 am calm
Leat 21.22 S
Long 31.21 W

March 10 This day begins and ends with light Easterly winds ship on the Starboard tack the deck attending to ship duty.

Long 31.44 W

March 11 This day wind from the E.N. East also rain squalls latter part calm on sail going the same way as usual.
