Monday 3 This day begins with moderate weather began cutting the whales at 1.30 got the whales all cut in and kept the ship off N.W. West Lat 36.58 N

May 4 1909

This day begins with moderate weather began holling at 9 AM raised school of sperm whales lowered 3 boats but did not get fast so came on board with no whale and started the work again Lat 36.55 N
Long 74.12 W

Wed 5. This day begins & ends with good whaling weather engaged boiling and got all through at 6.30 P.M.

Thurs 6. This day began stowing the oil below weather good at 3.30 raised a school of whales going quick to the windward lowered 3 boats and tried to head the whales off but could not so had to return on board with no whales Lat 37.00 N
Long 74.15 West by dead R

Friday 7. See a school of goats early this morning lowered 3 boats but the whales were going quick to the windward no chance to get to the whales Lat 37.07 N
Long 74.20 West

Sat 8 To day we are having good weather the work busy setting up the main rigging as it was very black Lat 37.00 N
