This day begins with moderate trades
Schr making good time the watch
overhaling the cutting spades just at
sundown raised a sail & points of the
port bow a long distance off shore
the day with masthead attended
to 1 dead 2531 H. dead 3522 M

Wed 11th. To day we are having fine
weather nothing in sight mast
head attended to & sharp the
mate with the men attending
to ship duty. latter part the wind
blew a little more to the East
So ends the day dead 2714 dead 3702

Thurs 12th. This day begins & ends with light
baffling wind from N East to East
nothing near we are getting hungry for
a whale. dead 2822 dead 3816 M

Frid 13th. To day the weather has been fine
with the wind very light from the
East have seen nothing so at
sundown furled the mainsail
thinking we might see a whale
in the morning. dead 2936 M

This day begins & ends with strong winds
from the V. East also a bad sea running
see a large piece of squid & lots of
birds. dead 3102 dead 4218 West

Mon 16th. To day begins & ends with squally
weather & light rains latter part
the wind moderated down to very
wind Schr with foresail & main
trysail set steering N by N 1/2 E
have seen nothing to day. ends
the day dead 3150. dead 4317 M
