

Wed Jun 15 1921

This day begins with fair weather wind from the West. at 800 AM sighted a sail away into the East from us proved to be the schooner Cameo Capt Adams he had been cruising into the North about 3010 Sat Long 4721 West had seen whales a number of times. Capt Cleveland went on board of her and staid until supper time they were very short of provisions & tobacco. The brother supplied them with what he could share & ended the day. Sat 3140 Sat Long 4730 West

Thurs 16 To day begins with moderate winds from the West. Sch. starting off to the North. the Sch. Cameo in sight all the running off. see porpoises at sundown shorten sail. Sat 3232 Sat Long 4736 West

Frid 17 1921 To day begins with moderate breezes from the West at 120 PM raised a breach 4 fow miles away it proved to be a school of sperm whales lowered 3 three boats but could not strike as the whales seemed to be very thin.

Sat 30.07 Long 4704 W

Sat 18 1921

To day begins & ends with fresh S.W. West winds Sch. cruising sea porpoise Sat 3312 Long 4710 W

Sunday 19 June 1921

This day begins with heavy weather also a bad sea running. Sch. laying with the 2 mts. trysails with middle part the wind moderated a very little so set the foresail just at supper time see a large piece of squid looking fresh. Sat 3315 Long 4734

Mon 20

To day begins & ends with very heavy weather. Sch. under storm trysails on different tack. Capt gave out tobacco & ends the day. Sat 3329 Sat Long 4740 West

Tues 21

This day begins and ends as yesterday with very fair & shaking weather. Sch. under main trysail & foresail a lce fidd with a very bad sea running. Sch. heading W. must see nothing encouraging. Sch. ends the June day Sat 3324 Long 4746 West

Wed 22

This day we have had strong breezes with a very bad running. Sch. under main trysail & foresail all day see 1 or 2 sail called it the Cameo also caught a dolphin at sundown squall from the westward.
