 stove went boat saved the line and strong

 took them along side and got ready to cut

Sunday Nov 14th
 this day calm with calm com to end with
 6-30 P M finished 11 1/2 H in while taking
 in fluke shores but one at night com to
 sail light winds from N E ship under
 short sail heading to the N west
