Thursday Feb 24th
 this day fine with light winds ship
 stood in shore at day light until dark
 and then was ship took in light sail
 and fore sail

Lat 17-40 S
 Long 10-41 E

Friday Feb 25th
 this day light winds at daylight made
 all sail and started at 2 P.M.
 saw land about three miles distant
 at 3-30 were ship, and stood to the
 at night took in light sails but cannot
 find land

Saturday Feb 26th
 this day light winds from the S
 ship stood standing off to the N
 at 10 P.M. raised about small
 whales lowest saw boats took three
 whales first second third caught a whale
 fourth mate lost his iron roak after
 took whales along side got up the
 cutting gear but did not come to end
 no ops

Sunday Feb 27th
 this day light winds called all hands at
 day light and cut the three whales at noon
 and made sail ship standing to the N
 at night ship came to the S.W.
 Lat 17-48 S
 Long 10-44 E

Monday Feb 28th
 this day fine with light winds ship standing
 to the S.W. with topsail out at night took
 in light sails and was ship still sailing
 Lat 17-40 S
 Long 10-40 E

Tuesday March 1st
 this day fine with light breeze ship
 standing to the S.W. at 4 P.M.
 took ship and at night took in light
 sails and fore sail Lat 18-41 S
 Long 11-10 E

Wednesday March 2nd
 this day fresh trades slowed down sail
 about 2 P.M. did not finish saw a
 whale thought it was a sperm whale
 lowered out it was a common whale
 Lat 18-50 S
 Long 11-10 E

Thursday Mar 3rd
 this day fresh trades ship cruising
 finished slowing down about 3 P.M.
 at night shortened sail 18-20 S
 Lat 10-41 E
 Long
