sail Lat 18-02 S
Long 10-34 E

Friday Mar 6th
this day fresh trades ship on E turn back
at 8-30 saw large ^{whale} going to the windward
quick lowered the boat but could not
get to windward of him at night went
on the other tack Lat 18-18 S
Long 10-55 E

Saturday Mar 7th
this day light trades ship stood in
to the E ward in the fore noon and to the
H ward in the afternoon saw lots of
blackfish and squid at night shortened
sail and new Lat 17-35 S
Winds Copland Long 11-57 E

Sunday Mar 8th
this day fresh trades ship cruising
at night ship on Port tack with
short sail Lat 17-14 S
Long 10-20 E

Monday Mar 9th
this day fine with light trades ship standing
to the H ward with all sail out at night
took in light sail and one ship
Lat 17-55 S
Long 10-55 E

Tuesday Mar 10th
this day light trades ship standing off
H by N with all sail out at night
came to on E turn back took in light sails
Lat 17-40 S
Long 9-55 E

Wednesday Mar 11th
this day fine with light trades ship on
Starboard tack at 8-30 tacked ship at night
shortened sail at 5-30 P M there was refusal
duly would not break out fresh water put them
in iron Lewis in Silva Anton Davis and
Korella Degrad Lat 17-10 S
Long 10-19 E

Thursday Mar 12th
this day fine with light trades saw whales
at 8-30 there were men in iron turned to
ship lowered four boats hand boat caught
two whales handboard boat one how boat
struck tow but lost one took them
aboard ship at 5 P M no obs

Friday Mar 13th
this day fine with new light trades
called all hands at day light and came
to and finished at 10 thirty at night
came to boat ship heading to the
H ward Lat 16-55 S
Long 10-02 E
