

Monday March 14th

this day fine with very light trades
were ship, at sun rise sheet stowed in
on Starboard tack at night shortened
sail still boiling Lat 16-46° E
Long 10-06° E

Tuesday Mar 15th

this day fine with light winds from the
S. H. ship heading S by E with all sail out
finished boiling at 8 P.M. at night
shortened sail Lat 16-38° E
Long 10-38° E

Wednesday Mar 16th

this day light winds from the S. H.
ship heading S by E with all sail out
pumping water getting ready to stow
oil at night saw large whale three miles
on the weather bow did not lower

Lat 17-02° E
Long 10-38° E

Thursday Mar 17th

this day fine with light breeze com to
stow down at day light at six raised
whales stowed down about 38 Bbls
at 7.30 lowered three boats and a little
later lowered the cutter boat each boat
caught a whale the third water caught
a large one took them alongside at 2.30
got dinner and com to eat finished the
three small whales at 7 P.M.
got supper and set the watch in st

Friday Mar 18th

this day fresh trades call all hands at
day light and com to cut out it was so
rough that we lost the lead after it
was cut off no obs

Saturday Mar 19th

this day fresh trades ship under short
sail boiling later part day weather
a little better Lat 16-16° E
Long 10-11° E

Sunday Mar 20th

this day light trades and calm finished
boiling at 5 P.M. ship on Starboard
tack with topsail out Lat 16-12° E
Long 9-58° E

Monday Mar 21st

this day fine with light trades ship
heading in to the Eward with topsail
out. Pumping water getting ready to stow
down oil Lat 16-16° E
Long 10-38° E

Tuesday March 22nd

this day light winds ship on Eward tack
with topsails out stowed down about 80
Bbls Oil at four P.M. saw whales
lowered three boats went boat struck
cutter did not get fast took whale
along side at dusk
