

Wednesday Mar 28th

this day fresh trades called all hands at daylight and out the wharfe before 11 AM and then were ship and stood to the N ward at 11:30 AM saw a brack and at 2 PM lowered three boats Harboar boat got two Throat boat one and bow boat one took last whale along side at sunset Lat 15-38 S Long 10-08 E

Thursday Mar 29th

this day light trades called all hands at 5 AM and came to and finished at 2 PM at 8 PM came to boil ship on the western tack with short sea Lat 15-48 S Long 10-40 E

Friday Mar 30th

this day fine with light winds ship heaving on the Eastern tack with topsail out still boiling Lat 15-46 S Long 10-22 E

Saturday 26th

this day fine with light winds finished boiling at 10 PM ship still on E tack heaving S 72 N with topsail and fore sail out Lat 15-45 S Long 10-54 E

Sunday Mar 27th

this day fine with light winds ship with all sail out stowing down sail did not finish stowed about 80 fathoms Lat 15-58 S Long 10-55 E

Monday Mar 28th

this day fine with fresh trades ship on Eastern tack with topsail out at night took in fore sail and uper topsail and went around on the other tack finished stowing down about 90 fathoms Lat 15-46 S Long 10-55 E

Tuesday Mar 29th

this day fresh trades with heavy swell ship went around on Starboard tack at 8:30 AM ship with reef main sail and lower topsail Lat 15-34 S Long 10-08 E

Wednesday Mar 30th

this day fine with light trades ship on the Eastern tack at 8:30 raised the land at 5 PM were ship and took in light sails and fore sail Lat 15-32 S Long 11-41 E

Thursday Mar 31st

this day fine with light trades at daylight kept off down the coast at 7:30 came to an anchor at Melimades
