 had his whale run down took three
 whales alongside at 12 P. M. and two
 but ship loaded so heavy we did
 not cut the other whale

Monday Jan 9th
 this day light wind from S. W.
 ship with short sail finished cutting
 at 6 P. M. and then came to boil
 Lat 34-22 S

 ship with short sail at noon saw
 shoal young Bull whales lowered
 four boats barboard boat struck
 one took him alongside at 4 P. M.
 Lat 34-34 S
 Long 8-02 W

Wednesday Jan 11th
 called all hands at daylight and
 cut the whale and then stowed down
 a little over 40 Bbls and at night
 came to boil Lat 34-50 S
 Long 8-12 W

Thursday Jan 12th
 this day light wind from the S.
 at 6-30 P. M. we saw three small whales
 going lowered three boats but did not
 see them from the boats stowed down
 about twenty Bbls oil Lat 34-15 S
 Long 7-20 W

Friday Jan 13th
 this day light wind finished stowing
 down stowed down about 24 Bbls
 Lat
 Long

Saturday Jan 14th
 this day light wind from the S.
 ship Thetis in to the westward
 at night took ship Lat 34-25 S
 Long 7-48 W

Sunday Jan 15th
 this day fresh breeze from the S. W.
 ship working off to the Emerald with easy
 sail at noon heeled on the wind at night
 shortened sail Lat 33-48 S
 Long 7-02 W

 this day fresh wind ship with short
 sail heading to the W. wind
 Lat 33-42 S
 Long 7-12 W
