 at shortest sail Lat 34-08 S
 Long 4-26 W

Tuesday Jan 31st
 this day fresh breeze from the S
 ship steaming S E by E with topsails
 out took flyjib in and repaired to
 and bent it again at night shortened
 sail Lat 34-01 S
 Long 2-35 W

Wednesday Feb 1st
 this day light breeze from the W
 ship with easy sail at 5 P M
 saw a large whale lowered three
 reports three men struck took
 whale along side at 10 P M
 took back by wind even on fleet
 at 4 P M set men
 Lat 34-04 S
 Long 1-23 W

Thursday Feb 2^d
 this day very light wind and calm
 finished cutting and set to sail
 ship with short sail no off

Friday Feb 3^d
 this day light wind ship with short
 sail still boiling Lat 33-47 S

 this day light wind from the W
 ship steaming off to the S E with
 topsails out finished boiling repaired
 Bow Port at night shortened sail
