 Long 9-52 E

Thursday Mar 21st
 this day light trades ship steaming
 off N N E with all sail out at
 night come to the wind and shortened
 sail Lat 18-27 S
 Long 9-45 E

Friday Mar 22nd
 this day light trades ship steaming
 E N E with all sail out at noon halted
 on the wind on star tack at night
 shortened sail Lat 17-45 S
 Long 10-00 E

Saturday Mar 23rd
 this day very light winds from
 the N E at 9.30 saw whales going
 quick lowered for them but did
 not see them from the boats
 set up Spruce at night shortening
 sail Lat 17-15 S
 Long 10-22 E

Sunday Mar 19th
 this day very light trades ship with all
 sail out at night shortened sail Lat 17-50 S
 Long 10-01 E

Monday Mar 20th
 this day very light winds and calm
 ship with all sail out still out work
 on calk Lat 17-50 S
 Long 10-37 E

Tuesday Mar 21st
 this day light ship with all sail out
 standing to the seaward at night tack
 ship and shortened sail Lat 17-57 S
 Long 11-04 E

Wednesday Mar 22nd
 this day light trades with heavy sea saw
 whales at 8-30 going quick lowered for
 them but did not see them from boats
 Lat 17-50 S
 Long 10-35 E

Thursday Mar 23rd
 this day light trades at 8.30 A.M. raised
 a whale lowered four Boats Throat Boat
 struck at 10.2 P.M. took him along
 side at 4 P.M. saw a school small
 whales lowered three Boats to Bone
 Wh Bone bow Boat two took them along
 side at dusk Lat 17-42 S
