 saw Shoal small whales at 7 PM
 lowered three Boats and worked
 to the windward caught three
 small whales to Boat two of Boat
 one towed them off to the ship took
 them along side at dusk

Sunday July 9th
 this day some very light winds
 call all hands at daylight
 and corn to out finished 11 AM
 at night corn to boil

 boiling at five PM
 Lat 30-50 N

 this day very light winds and calm
 Stowed cargo for oil

Wednesday July 12th
 this day light wind from the S
 Ship Steaming N^W with all square
 sails out Stowed down about 4 PM
 Bobs out Lat 31-08 N
 Long 51-54 W

Thursday July 13th
 this day light winds Ship working
 to the N^W with all sail out at night
 took in light sails Lat 31-45 N
 Long 52-16 W

Friday July 14th
 this day very light winds Ship
 with Eby sail not moving at night
 Movers and Silva towed off the crew
 were fighting did not stop put them in
 irons
