Monday July 17th
 this day light winds ship working to the
 N.W. with all sail out saw large whale
 at noon lowered four boats but could
 not get fast took boats up at dusk
 Lat 31-44 N
 Long 62-48 W

Tuesday July 18th
 this day light winds ship heading
 N.W. with all sail out later part
 day speak Brig Sullivan
 Lat 31-50 N
 Long 62-51 W

Wednesday July 19th
 this day with fresh breeze from the
 S.W. ship heading N.W. with topsails
 out at night took in fore sail
 Lat 32-10 N
 Long 63-00 W

Thursday July 20th
 this day light winds from S.W. ship
 heading N.W. with all sail out
 Lat 32-34 N
 Long 63-01 W

Friday July 21st
 this day light winds from the S.W. ship
 heading to the N.W. at noon saw a
 large whale lowered three boats hoisted
 boat struck and then the H boat took
 him along side before sun set
 Lat 32-51 N
 Long 63-19 W

Saturday July 22nd
 this day light S.W. winds calmed all hands
 four and came to anchor at 4 P.M.
 and then came to boat
 Lat 32-52 N
 Long 62-50 W

Sunday July 23rd
 this day very light winds from the S.W.
 ship still boiling
 Lat 32-53 N
 Long 62-50 W

Monday July 24th
 this day light winds ship steering
 to the N. and westward with all sail
 out at night saw several whales long
 way off lowered four then but did
 not see them from boats finished
 boiling
 Lat 32-56 N
 Long 63-04 W

Tuesday July 25th
 this day very light winds from the S.W.
 ship steering N.W. with all sail out
 steering down sail but did not finish
 Lat 32-41 N
 Long 63-11 W
