

Bark Faniel Webster Cruising in the

Remarks on Board Saturday Aug 9th

All day blowing heavy from S. E. and a
up to heavy swell running. At 10 last night
hoisted in main staysail. - Then ship at 8
M. and set fore, main, and foretopmast
sails heading up E. by S. tried sounding
and judged ourselves in about 30 fathoms.

In the P. M. saw a sail on Starb, but
standing to the S. W. but afterwards saw
her work ship to the E., at sunset moder-
ating a little set fore and main topsails.
Lat. 30° 05' S. Long. 49° 20' W.

Sunday Aug. 10

All day strong breezes from S. E. and
weather ship steering E. by S. and E. all the
M. In the P. M. steering E. by S. E. with
all sail on. At 4 rounded and got 30
fathoms Cape Rio Grande bearing E. by N.
Dist 60 miles. All the P. M. in heavy
water until 4. At 3 passed a ship
mast with gall mast and attached - had
the appearance of having been carried away.
Lat. 33° 12' S. Long. 31° 25' W.

Monday Aug. 11

Come in with moderate breezes from S. E.
and cloudy weather. Ship steering to the E. by
E. with all sail out cruising. Several sail
in sight all bound to the S. W. Saw one sail
no sails on foremast - suppose she had them
blown away in the late gale. In the P. M.
wind hauling to the E. at 8 P. M. wind
E. by S. ship by the wind to the E. by S. E. saw
three finbacks. Water blue and but
few birds. Lat. 32° 21' S. Long. 38° 40' W.

Tuesday Aug. 12th

Come in with fresh breezes from S. W.
wind changing suddenly in the night. Ship
steering E. by S. E. with all prudent sail
saw several sail working to the S. W.
if they crippled. Lat. 31° 45' S. Long. 49° 30' W.

Remarks on Board Wednesday Aug 13th

Come in with moderate breezes from S. W. and
clear weather. Ship steering E. by S. and E. by S. E.
as the sails will best fill. In the A. M. saw
a finback cow & calf going to the E. W. In the
P. M. saw a large school of Buppes and a school
of Killies, all going to the E. W. - Nothing more
in sight. Lat. 30° 26' S. Long. 49° 20' W.

Thursday Aug. 14th

Come in with light air from the S. W. and calm
with fine weather. Ship working to the E. by S. with
all sail out, cruising. Saw several finbacks and
two turtles. Nothing more in sight all day.
Lat. 29° 31' S. Long. 46° 04' W.

Friday Aug. 15th

Come in with moderate breezes from E. by S. and
fine weather. Ship by the wind to the E. by S. E.
with all sail out cruising. Saw through the
day plenty of finbacks, but a few birds.
Nothing more in sight all day. Lat. 30° 03' S. Long. 46° 04' W.

Saturday Aug. 16th 1879

Come in with moderate breezes from E. by S.
E. and fine weather. Ship by the wind to the E.
with all sail out cruising. Saw several fin-
backs through the day and two sail steering to
the S. W. also saw jammers. Lat. 30° 26' S.

Sunday Aug. 17th

Come in with moderate breezes from the
E. by S. and fine weather. Ship by the wind to the
E. by S. with all sail out cruising. Nothing
in sight but finbacks. - At 6 P. M. tacked
Ship to the E. W.

Lat. 30° 29' S. Long. 40° 20' W.
