Monday the wind strong from the east.
Got my discharge from the copia and
went on board the daniel and stood
all hands two regular late the night
Tuesday the 26
in the morning sowed down the cable
dry in the onions fixing the boats saw
p and pin back
Wednesday the 27
raining the most part of the night
threatened two thrown man over board
but out the starboard boat on the cains
calm
Thursday the 28
alm the most part the day four
painted in heavy sea
Friday the 29
in the morning light winds mended
ing the ship in good sea
sailing time
Saturday the 30
all the day a very cloudy rain
and wind blew strong with
apt. the topsails
the out meet
Sunday the 31
in the morning strong breeze
double reefed the topsail
the gip and main sail
New year's day 1854 Monday
in the morning break out a
blowing with squalls snow
part of the day
Tuesday the 2
in the morning blowing strong
double reefed the
sails wind at 10
