

Journal on board ship Daniel Wood
year 1855 January 1st
Sunday the wind from northward
and west was fine gust squall of rain
saw land thirty miles from Boston
and longitude 168 8 latitude 54

Monday the 2nd
in the morning frequent showers of
rain broke out water and clearing out
the main hatch in the lat part off the
day strong wind

Tuesday the 3rd
in the morning broke out water strong
wind not much going on day ends
with strong winds

Wednesday the 4th
in the morning strong wind
saw two sail saw wellant's island
and other islands and deep reefed
the top sails filled the gale and main
sail

Thursday the 5th
went two stension barbar middle
he got foul the wildcat badger
carried pling gib born and
our banner born

Friday the 6th
laring the rigging set up the
bob stays hauled the ship ahead
and fringed great deal

Saturday the 7th
in the morning took a raft off
cask on shore got some wood
watchi wanted two raisins but
we ate the coardest play

Sunday the 8th
in the morning home looked on the
shore

Journal of the ship Daniel Wood
got fifteen boat load of wood
about ninety bbls water the most un
satisfied natives in all asen son
of ter six hundred days we got wind
went two see it was on the bench
off february Friday broke water
head most pleasant weather

Saturday the 11th
This day pleasant and the faint
ing ship and working sail

Sunday the 12th
in the morning pleasant week
wind light

Monday the 13th
Painting ship making small
ropes

Tuesday the 14th
in the morning wind light parting
ship rattling the rigging

Wednesday the 15th
light winds saw sail making
splitting shaft

Thursday the 16th
in the morning saw land
sent down the main sail and
got it sat lining port and main
rigging

Friday the 17th
light winds bent the main sail
broke out water rattling rigging
the rigging

Saturday the 18th
in the morning rattling the
rigging over hauling the cutting
block
