

Daniel Wood ship yeare 1805 Feb 17
Sun day the weather calm and rising
at night blow strong reefed the top sails

Monday the 20
in the morning drafted main sail dalt line
up the rigging hauling the lash in line the
crew hoisted anchor and hauled the ship
to the cable blocks and hauled

Tuesday the 21 in the morning
set sail for a short time breaking the
fore hatch for a small amount

Wednesday the 22
in the morning wind light
sail in light wind setting main
top gaff sail about out head

Thursday the 23
in the morning wind light
the boat was the copper rivets
found in the 24

Friday the 24
in the morning wind light
set up for a short time
2 W

Sunday the 26
in the morning calm and the
at anchor got light and
left for the 27

Monday the 27
in the morning saw the bushes islands
break slops escaping mast

Tuesday the 28
in morning wind from the 28 and light

Year 1805 March the 1 Wednesday
soon after the midnight hour came
two blue look in two closed main tops
sail and fore top mast staisant were in
the Chinese sea

Thursday the 2
in the morning wind we set down made
sail saw some half does on sails and
quite unusual off Chinese goods saw
land called it Hong Kong

Friday the second 3
in the morning saw the land took pilot
went two anchor in Hong Kong flew
out

Saturday the 3
in the morning watch went for
shore painted the boats at night
Pierce came off drunk the
mate went two starting him off
the fast they put him in irons they
kell of pray the mate struck him
twice with a whip ten days got two hundred
bushels off potatoes some tea corks and
baind ship got under way 17 Saturday
went out about 30 miles and came two
fished the sails

Sunday 18
in the morning got under way went
out two sea toward the cable and anchors
got in the boat ready for more off
the 19

Monday the 19
in the thick weather head wind saw
land and plenty off goods on
with light winds N E

Tuesday 20
in the morning Doubtless top sail
bores a leg wind saw goods on ship
back about 20 land in sight
