

of 1855 March the 21st wednesday

in the morning wind strong as usual ship used to sail away the fore mast sail sail saw the land sail junks and a small boat a little

this day the 22 strong breeze with gale pilled rave a new down hant the cooper is out of his head quite cold some sun off a way account

friday the 23 in the morning brook water met saw large quantity off junk wind vary strong reefed the top sails over ship vary wet crop out off his head

saturday the 24 in the morning sent down ray a year old strong breeze sail saw the land to top some better break out ship's ship was wet and comfortable

sunday the 25 brook water with single reefed top sail cloudy in afternoon made more sail saw a fore top sail, sooner fins back and bar poses

Monday the 26 in the morning moderate weather sail an light brook water molasses washed the geese the old cock all day on deck

tuesday the 27 in the morning washed the hogs roped up the fore top galant sail make straps two blocks the third mate and the in the kitchen weather moderate cloudy

wednesday the 28 in the morning raised heavier water moderate weather sent out ding sails steering east for japan some water green making water

year 1855 March, 29, thursday

in the morning double reefed top sail sea by moderate and over and over in the broa Purdie saw gads reef and reef perriable

friday the 30 in the morning hole sail breeze over haaled mantop lifts saw the land sizing the boats knotting, reams and all knots japs,

saturday the 31 moderate weather some raining no sun break meet and molasses this is molasses the old saw had spigs

sunday the 1st April the 1st day both wind making very good occurs for the at the ocean sea saw sail to windward heading near by her wise

Monday the 2nd in the morning double reefed the top sail and wind for every quarter raining very hard moderate down towards night

Tuesday the 3rd in the morning brook water moderate weather new for and main braces killed gads we had double reefed top sail clearing off

wednesday the 4th in the morning moderate weather moderate reefed in top sail lift saw whole down did not bring more off them have exercise all around

thursday the 5th in the morning saw new main top sail only yards sent a new second hand main top sail mending the old one for forward the calm the 1855 or 1856 looked like bad weather in the japan saw black fish

friday the 6th in the morning light wind and raining continued with the day mending the top sail breeze freshening saw the land two abends
