Sunday the 4

wind from the north clear weather fine prospect afternoon we had goose for dinner and out of we have may baked like shovels

Monday the 5

in the morning broke out water bent the new fore top sail and mending the other fine day

Tuesday the 6

in the morning sent the fore sail down mended it sent it aloft it gained clean in the end of the windles mended second mate had row was fine weather wind NE

Wednesday the 7

in the morning pleasant as usual broke meet overed the after hole taring the top sails sheets

Thursday the 8

in the morning taring the sheets mending fore top mast stay sail saw the land distant and rock that is sail breeze and pleasant weather to go

Friday the 9

in the morning wind strong square yards mended the fore top mast stay sail and mended the sheets and bent them

Saturday the 10

wind from the S.W. blowing strong heat till four in the morning rain the hour to raining the most part of the day

Sunday the 11

in the morning wind strong mended fore top sail mended NE sat the get mainmast

April the 16 Monday

in the morning it had moderate saw a sail proved to be the China game with her making sugar and seized on leading board

Tuesday the 17

in the morning sent down the mizen top sail mended it bent it again broke out saw the sail it was moderate all night breezy up all day

Wednesday the 18

through the night kept busy in going look visible blowing strong with the guard yards had goose for dinner

Thursday the 19

continued moderate cleaned the cooler wind from the S.W. west foggy

Friday the 20

moderate weather and calm in the morning breeze up in the morning foggy morning cold all day all sorts of goods for the winter ships

Saturday the 21

wind from N.W. all sail one hauled cutting fabul the water in 39 degrees in L.L. the air is varied the lining very poor

Sunday the 22

during the night frequent snow continued through day strong breeze some times reef top sail same as before

Monday the 23

in the morning squally broke meet sent in the old get but new one sails blowing strong reef top sails

Tuesday the 24

in the night many squalls saw sails 4 gained with side rope edgar broke water bread meet from whales and lowered the had some potatoes for the
