ice sails 3. Stowed down ice barrels
blowing gale off wind at night
11 o'clock sailed

Tuesday the 15
blowing gale off wind and snowing
all day very thick close reefed
top sail

wednesday the 16
in the morning more rated
hauled up picked up dead whale
belong to the A B L. sails 3 killed
the other hags

thursday the 17
pleasant weather sailing. gamed with
sister and sold her potatoes ice sails 10
49 and 20 fine barrels off in the
harbor

friday the 18
pleasant weather whale ice barrels
sails 30. spoke the bark Louisa and Edgar
finished hauling coaled at night

saturday the 19
in the morning strong breeze
blowing down. Stowed ice barrels
sails 30. finished the fore and main
top sails

sunday the 20
in the morning foggy rainy snow
breaking out. shook. sails 10
gamed with Washington

Monday the 21
in the morning saw sails 38 ice
foggy. raining. 11 o'clock home
on

Tuesday the 22
three twenty four hours foggy sails 3
scrapping home

wednesday the 23
in the morning saw whale lower
harbor. boat struck saw journal sails 20
several ship cutting whale. blowing
breeze could not sail

thursday the 24

in the morning ice shales under moderate
weather gamed with on land and on water

friday the 25

in morning ice foggy and raining sails 17
making best and east. sundry in the water

saturday the 26

this day foggy break shoals made home pen
stowed away at night cleared up saw whales
ice sails 49.

sunday the 27

this day foggy double reef top sails ice
sails 11

Monday the 28

in the morning foggy heavy snow
in strong breeze in all bad weather

in morning ice moderate weather foggy in the
afternoon gaming with Carcase sails 0

wednesday the 30

in the morning foggy spoke with runner

thursday the 31

in morning island whales hauled two times
