

October the 1 Monday Oct 30

Strong southerly wind heavy sea boats
at slow down oil and sundries ten bbls
sails getting bad weather

Tuesday the 2
Side of ship rainy gaming got
nine bbls oil. blow strong during
night

Wednesday the 3
this morning snowing blow strong
tack in the old boat sails against the
medium star for the island gaming

Thursday the 4
pleasant weather boats cruising scraped
then made the Japan harbor
gaming

Friday the 5
in the morning hove up the anchor
and star for island and with we had 8 in
ches snow on deck adding 10 bbls anchor and
june 1st bag course 1 bag

Saturday the 6
hole sail breezy rain in water at the
mizen can shak led the cables and slow them
down clearing S.E.

Sunday the 7
thick weather strong breeze taking in
sail and making the head wind one sail

Monday the 8
broke out water foggy rainy wind
from south and east blowing strong
afternoon and night scraped the works

Tuesday the 9
during the night the wind blew
gale stage reefed main top sail gale content

Wednesday the 10
the gale moderated but on double reefed top
sails and 1/2 hove down snells of rail cold

Thursday the 11
have two with night some heavy squalls
in the morning clearing S.E. sails 2
double reefed top sails

October the 12 year 1855

pleasant weather bent under flying gibe and
main sail rove some new rigging brook bread
and water gamed with drasaw sails 5

Saturday the 13
this day foggy reefed top sail sent down
cutting gear wind from the south and fifty miles
from home

Sunday the 14
this day blowing gale of wind very heavy gale
wind southe east one sail in sight rained
most of the night

Monday the 15
in morning wind N.W. blowing strong clearing
east hove two 60 miles from the passage sails 4

Tuesday the 16
in the morning wind to southerly all sail had
sun all day we saw land entered the passage and in
all proper bil itys got through if we do in all prop
orbitals for ever for me sails 7

Pacific Ocean Wednesday the 17
in the morning wind from the W. clearing new
rigging all sails out clearing east with east sails

Thursday the 18
this day moderate weather mending old
studding sails wind southerly at night blow on

Friday the 19
in the morning foggy wind southerly at
noon wind hauled round westward blow moderate
gale rove new main top gale and bottom
sails

Saturday the 20
this day the gale continued in the afternoon
heavy squally double main top reefed
and close reefed sail 1

Sunday the 21
during the night blowst heard deer ring the
day the gale abated made sail wind two
sails

Monday the 22
this day moderate soft studding sails clearing
new rigging wind hauled in various quarters
