rained all night and up day to noon then
wind hauled round west. double reefed top sails
most of the time jib and mainsail filled. Lat-
tude 25 crossed the meridian

west longitude 16
this day is omitted in the log of the week strong
breeze from the N.W. westward cleared missing
meridian wind increased two galls on a sail

Wednesday the 25
in the morning pleasant weather scraping
the cars patching patching the rigging steering east
south east wind west

Thursday the 26
this day pleasant weather wind westward
taring rigging back anchor studding sails out
Latitude 170 west

Friday the 27
wind N.E. it rize from most calm two
double reefed top sails it came on by inches
course E. east south east

Saturday the 28
in morning had usual strong wind from
north east reefed top sails water flying in all
parts of the ship

Sunday the 29
blowing gale from the north east put
stopper foot of the fore top sail put jack
stay all fore of

Monday the 30
this day gale moderated made some sail
raining wind south east a red eastward

Tuesday the 31
this day the brook out head water
washed waist board raising wind E. E.
various ways rigging

year 1855 November 1 Wednesday

raining most of the day double reefed top
sails filled main sail and got under way
wind S.E. Latitude 34-32 Longitude 622

Thursday the 2
in the morning wind S.E. strong at noon
hauled aft and continued hauling at fore aft
course S.E. thick most of the day

Friday the 3
reparing rigging scraping cars and overhauling
all sail squalls off noon night proved pleasant
wind S.E.

Saturday the 4
this day brook out meet water shook
cask washed down the main mast wind S.E.
moderate weather

Sunday the 5
pleasant weather brook water tight wind
S.E. &

Monday the 6
this day moderate washing bone. Shook
wheel house taring rigging and mending
g. S. & d

Tuesday the 7
washing bone reparing rigging wind S.E. strong
pleasant strong wind

Wednesday the 8
in the morning strong wind bursted the jib
hastened it taring rather rigging

Thursday the 9
in the morning
wind strong S.E. longitude 155.14 latitude 34

Friday the 10
this day strong S.E. wind washed the ship
various things done at the board

Saturday the 11
in the morning had wind in at night
squalls of rain ship's schooner roadster from home
not good

Sunday the 12
in the morning watchmen went on shore
plenty of rain lost the main sail
