

February the 18 Sunday 1866

this day pleasant light wind from north north east coarse quite warm sliding sails out harbor, latitude 24 0

Monday the 19

the last night calm in the morning breezed from N.E. draping bane and hides saw away sliding sails

Tuesday the 20

this day thick and fogged rainy good breeze close reefed top sail wind east and more northward. at 10 o'clock sailway heard broke wooden belt being in

wednesday the 21

sail in sight made sail west pole wind to the south

Thursday the 22

sent down maintop again sail on eye it went to again - wind shifted eastward in the night calm the most part of the day

Friday the 23

this day raining and foggy wind north wind northward. looked ship got times on board

Saturday the 24

this day the wind moderate west breeze wind north

Sunday the 25

this day pleasant weather moderate winds fresh nothing to get of any count latitude 29 7

February the 26 Monday

in the morning tacked ship twice broke out sunset and fresh pleasant weather all sail out

Tuesday the 27

this day pleasant weather wind north parted the boat scraped and casks various other jobs latitude 29 tacked at

wednesday the 28

this day pleasant weather with hot sun painting ship over the top sail in sight ship heading N.E.

Thursday the 29

this day pleasant weather light wind calm two sails in sight spoke the splintered all hands in the after noon setting up and taring rigging

Friday the 30

this day pleasant weather one sail set stringing sails in the after working on the rigging scraped stringing boards

Saturday the 1

March 18 1866 this day pleasant ship up and down painting off. kept one sail in sight ship heading N.E.

Sunday the 2

this day moderate weather, one of the grand island in sight latitude 20 30 longitude 29

Monday the 3

pleasant weather moderate wind rigging one sail wind N.E. head nor w weather thick
