

42. Tuesday 28th July 1836
All these 24 hours fine breeze course
at 8 by 6 saw several sail all hands
employed in ship duty carried away by 6th Moon
Lat 39° 04'

Wednesday 29th July
First part of these 24 hours fine breeze spoke
Bark Governor of Salem bound to East Cape
at 3 made shores at night took in sail and
hove too latter spoke ship Armata of New London
bound South Atlantic Capt Muller came on board and
stuck in for the land saw 12 sail
Lat 39° 04'

Thursday 30th July
All these 24 hours Laying off and on one
boat on shore saw the schooner of W.B.
Columbia of New London Anawans Brig Boiling
and several Schooners and Brigs all hands
employed in ship duty

Friday 31st July
First part of these 24 hours fine Boat ashore
recruiting 4 ship Laying off & on all hands
employed in ship duty

Saturday 31st July
All these 24 hours fine weather one Boat
ashore all hands employed in ship duty

Sunday 31st July
All these 24 hours fine one Boat ashore
all hands employed at ship duty so ends
these 24 hours all well Dreamt of being at home

5. Monday 1st August 1836
All these 24 hours calm took your
potatoes on board and Onions so
ends these 24 hours

Tuesday 2nd August
All these 24 hours calm went on board
the Marcus Sag harbour bound East Cape

Wednesday 3rd August
All these 24 hours very light winds store
to sea 5 ships in sight so ends these 24
hours

Thursday 4th August
First part of these 24 hours calm shores in
sight and 5 ships in sight Boiling so ends
these 24 hours

Friday 5th August
All these 24 hours calm shores in sight
nothing more remarkable forenoon watch
below shores in sight

Saturday 6th August
All these 24 hours calm 1 ship in sight
catch a South plenty of Calamagrostis in
sight shores in sight

Sunday 7th August
All these 24 hours calm 2 sail in sight
nothing more remarkable

Monday 8th August
All these 24 hours calm shores in sight nothing
more remarkable

Tuesday 9th August
All these 24 hours calm shores in sight
