First part of these 24 hours light winds Middle
part fresh Breeze made the Island of Cayal.
Latter part more moderate

Monday 15th August
All these 24 hours fresh winds from the East
run down and lay off and on all night -
morning stood out Steering South

Tuesday 16th August
All these 24 hours strong winds from
East Steering S.E. nothing in sight & ends
then 24 hours

Wednesday 17th
All these 24 hours strong winds from the
East Steering S.E. nothing in sight
Lat 34° 01'

Thursday 18th August
All these 24 hours fine weather strong
Breeze Steering S.E. nothing in sight

Lat 33° 02'
Long by Lunar 23° 51'

Friday 19th August 1836
First part of these 24 hours strong winds from
the S.E. Steering S by E Middle & latter the
same Steering S by W Lat 29° 34' N

Saturday 20th August
First part of these 24 hours fine with a strong
Breeze from S by E course S by W nothing in sight
Lat 26° 47' N

Sunday 21th
First part strong Breeze from the S.E. 1 Ship in sight
course South, Middle the same course S.W. by E
nothing in sight Lat 24° 27' N
Long by Lunar 31° 44' W

Monday 22th August
First part of these 24 hours fine Breeze from -
the North course S.W. nothing in sight
Lat 22° 24' N
Long 32° 40' W

Tuesday 23th
First part these 24 hours fine Breeze from the S.E. course
S.W. all hands employed a Ship's Duty nothing in sight
Lat 20° 47'

Wednesday 24th
First part these 24 hours fine winds East, course S.W. by S
Middle the same latter more moderate all hands
employed a Ship's Duty Lat 19° 54'

Thursday 25th
First part of these 24 hours fine weather course S.W. by S
Middle the same latter part made the Island of St
Antonia all hands employed in Ship's Duty 1 Ship in sight

First part these 24 hours St Antonia South. course
