

Remarks On Board Ship Dartmouth from

Friday 30th September 1836

First part these 24 hours squally with rain squalls raised the topsails and hauled the mainsail latter part sat the main sail steering S by W

Saturday Oct 1st 1836 Lat 26° 43' South

First of these 24 hours a gale from the E.S.E. under close reefed main top sail middle & latter part the same raised the fore sail & sat it

Sunday 2nd Oct Lat 29° 26' S

First part of these 24 hours strong winds sat the top sails middle the same latter took in main top & allant sail steering S.E. by S

Monday 3rd Oct 1836 Long by L 22° 57' West

First part of these 24 hours strong winds with top sails out steering S.E. by S middle raised the top sails -

Tuesday 4th Oct 1836

First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the East steering S.E. by S with rain middle and latter fine wind from the West

Wednesday 5th Oct 1836

First part of these 24 hours fine steering E by S 1 sail in sight sent a new fore sail and main top & allant sail

Thursday 6th Oct 1836

First part of these 24 hours fine course E by S sent new top sails 1st & 2nd mizen 2 sail in sight

Friday 7th Oct 1836 Long 44° 46' Lunar

First part of these 24 hours fine steering S.E. by East 1 ship in sight nothing more remarkable

Saturday 4th Oct

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the N.W. course S.E. 1 ship in sight latter part the same course S.E. by E Lat 33° 49' South

Sunday 5th Oct 1836 cs

First part these 24 hours strong winds from the West North W. all sail out course S.E. by E nothing more remarkable

Monday 10th Oct

First part these 24 hours fine plenty of Birds 1 ship in sight latter employed in breaking out and fitting new boats etc

Tuesday 11th Oct

First these 24 hours employed in breaking out and stowing back casks and hoops all sail out course S.E. by E winds from the N.E. W. nothing more remarkable

Wednesday 12th Oct

First of these 24 hours fine weather winds from the N.E. W. all sail out course S.E. by E saw nothing

Thursday 13th Oct

On Meridian these 24 hours fine weather all sail out course S.E. by E saw Finbacks and 3 right whales

Friday 14th Oct

First part of these 24 hours strong breezes winds from the N.E. middle and latter rainy plenty of Birds in sight saw one right whale did not course nothing more remarkable

Saturday 15th Oct

First part of these 24 hours squally middle rainy wind from the West course E.S.E. saw plenty of Finbacks latter part strong breezes
