Monday 31<sup>st</sup> Oct

First part of these 24 hours a Gale from the N.E. & course S.E. by E with Top Sails set middle and latter the same winds from S.W. saw nothing

Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> Nov 1836

First part of these 24 hours wind from the N.E. & main top sail set middle and latter light breeze from the S.E. & all sail out

Wednesday 2<sup>nd</sup> Nov

First part these 24 hours fine weather with a light breeze from N.E. & course E.S.E. all sail out middle and latter the same saw nothing

Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> Nov

First part of these 24 hours fine strong Gale from the North Double Redd top sails middle took in fore & Mizzen top sails latter squally saw nothing

Friday 4<sup>th</sup> Nov

First part of these 24 hours fine with all sail out course S.E. by E winds North middle and latter squally Double Redd the top sails spoke ship Canton Packet of Bristol & 1 right whale

Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> Nov

First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the South course E by S middle & latter strong Gale course E.S.E.

Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> Nov

First part of these 24 hours strong Gale course E by S middle and latter more moderate set the fore & main Sailing sail saw nothing

Monday 7<sup>th</sup> Nov

First part of these 24 hours more moderate middle and latter the same set Sailing Sails and main Royal saw nothing

Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> Nov

First part of these 24 hours fine weather all sail out middle and latter the same course E.S.E. winds N.E. & W.

Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> Nov

First part of these 24 hours fine weather all sail out steering E.S.E. saw nothing

Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> Nov

First part of these 24 hours fine raised a School of Sperm Whales lowered at sun set and took a whale to the Starboard Boat and took him alongside middle the same latter cut him in

Friday 11<sup>th</sup> Nov

First part of these 24 hours fine saw a Sperm Whale lowered a chased him all day latter part lowered the Starboard Boat and struck and got stove to pieces and lost the Whale came on Board and commenced Whaling

Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> Nov

First part of these 24 hours fine weather course E by S Boiling nothing in sight so ended this day with plenty Work
