

Remarks On Board Ship Dartmouth from

Saturday 26th Nov

First part of these 24 hours fine weather course N.E. by E Middle and latter part the same saw finbacks nothing more remarkable

Sunday 27th Nov

Latt No W^{ind} this day

First part of these 24 hours fine weather wind from the South at 4 made the South West Cape of Van Diemens Land bearing N.E. Distance 20 miles at 5 o'clock backed ship and stood the Westward and Southward Middle and latter part light winds

Monday 28th Nov

Latt 44° 36' S

Long 146

First part of these 24 hours fine steering by the wind N by West saw a Caracal Middle part the same latter part strong breeze from the North steering E. S. E.

Tuesday 29th Nov

Latt 46° 22' S

Long 146° 14' E

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze from the North steering full & by or East Middle and latter a Gale took in top sails and fore course so ended these 24 hours

Wednesday 30th Nov

Latt 46° 50' South

First part of these 24 hours a Gale from the North Middle more moderate sat the fore sail and fore top sail course N.E.

Thursday 1st December

Latt 46° 38' S

First part of these 24 hours strong wind course N.E. by E Middle and latter more moderate saw nothing

Friday 2nd Dec

Latt 45° 23' S

Long by Lunar 153° 20' E

First part of these 24 hours strong breeze sent up fore top Gallant yard Middle and latter fine all sail set saw a right whale

Saturday 3rd December

First part of these 24 hours fine weather sent up fore top Gallant yard saw plenty of right whales and a great many birds Middle and latter the same course N.E. winds from the South

Long 158° 30' East

Sunday 4th Dec

First part of these 24 hours fine weather course N.E. Middle the same latter part saw a right whale lowered and struck to the waist Boat and took him alongside

Monday 5th Dec

Latt 40° 53' South

Long 158° 18'

First part of these 24 hours commenced cutting & finished and stood along course N.E. by E Middle and latter part the same commenced Boiling

Latt 39° 52' South

Long 160° 12' East

Tuesday 6th Dec

First part of these 24 hours fine weather Boiling without success cooled down steering N.E. by E Middle and latter the same commenced Boiling

Latt 38° 10' South

Long by Lunar 162° 18' East

Wednesday 7th Dec

First part of these 24 hours fine finished Boiling turned up 10th of oil Middle and latter almost calm course N.E. by E finished withing ship

Latt 37° 55' South

Thursday 8th Dec

First part of these 24 hours fine course N.E. by E with a light breeze Middle and latter the same saw Blackfish lowered and got one to the starboard Boat and set the waist Boat
