Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> Jan. 1857

First part of these 24 hours strong wind blow reefs Main Top Sail and fore sail commenced Birling Middle the same latter part saw a pod of large whales rugged did not lower

First part of these 24 hours rugged watch below other Birling Middle part the same latter part finished Birling under Blue reefed Main Top Sail

Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> Jan.

First part of these 24 hours weighed ship and cleared the decks saw a ship Middle part the same latter part sailing heading East

Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> Jan.

First part of these 24 hours fresh Gale from the S.W. Middle and latter part clear weather one sail in sight all hands employed in mending sails

Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> Jan.

First part of these 24 hours fine weather saw a ship Middle took in sail latter made sail spoke ship Wm. Simpson New Bedford 19 months out 1000 lbs Sperm Oil 500 lbs Right Whale

First part of these 24 hours fine weather spoke ship Mount Vernon Wamuckit Capt 15 months out 1100 lbs Oil latter part the same
