Friday March 10<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the E.S.E. with double reefed fore and main top sail and main sail a 7 took in sail and hove her too under main top sail and foresail Middle part squally with rain a daylight made sail and washed of decks and put the Mate off Duty for abusive language and hard words with Capt

Saturday March 11<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the E.S.E. all sail out steering E.N.E. Middle and latter part the same at 11 P.M. made the Island of Mimitura and stood in

Sunday March 12<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours strong Trade stood in for the land at 6 stood off under double reefed topsails heading East latter part raving with thunder & lightning heading off shore

Wednesday March 15<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours light winds from the North steering S by E & shortened sail latter the same all sail out

Thursday March 16<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours light winds and pleasant steering North Middle and latter squally nothing more remarkable

Friday March 17<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours pleasant with light winds Middle and latter part the same at 5 a.m. made the Island of Otaheite bearing E.N.W. distance 25 miles

Saturday March 18<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours pleasant weather steering E.N.W. Middle and latter the same bent the chains Otaheite 12 miles distance

Sunday March 19<sup>th</sup>

First part of these 24 hours pleasant weather with light winds from S.E. Middle and latter part the same
