

46 *Remarks On Board Ship Dartmouth.*

Thursday 13th April

First part of these 24 hours fine breeze from N.E. steering S.E. Middle part the same latter all hands employed in stowing down Oil
Lat 20° 32' South

Friday 14th April

First part of these 24 hours light Breeze from N.E. steering S.E. Middle part finished stowing down 70th Oil Lat 21° 14' South

Saturday April 15th

First part light Breeze from the N.E. Course S.E. Middle part the same latter part steering S.W. Lat 22° 30' S

Sunday April 16th

First part of these 24 hours fine Breeze N.E. & 6 took in sail Middle part squally latter Cloudy. Lat 22° 29' South

Monday April 17th

First part of these 24 hours fine Breeze from the N.E. & 3 a.m. made Chetivra distance 15 miles & 6 took in sail and hove to by the wind latter part made sail Lat 22° 19' S

Tuesday April 18th

First part of these 24 hours light Breeze from the East standing in to the land & 12 Clock left went on shore Middle and latter took in sail and stood off shore

Wednesday April 19th

First part of the 24 hours light winds from East with rain Middle part the same latter part took in sail heaving off shore squally

Thursday April 20th

First part of these 24 hours light breeze from N.E. Middle part the same steering in for the land

Friday April 21st

First part of these 24 hours light wind from N.E. steering in for the land & 6 squally heaving off shore with plenty thunder and sharp lightning Middle and latter part the same

Saturday April 22nd

First part of these 24 hours light wind from the North and pleasant Middle part wore ship and stood in & 8 Clock left went on shore at Chetivra and took off 6 boats loads of wood

Sunday April 23rd

First part of these 24 hours light winds from the North finished getting wood Middle part calm latter part light winds and pleasant Lat 22° 44' "

Monday April 24th

First part of these 24 hours light winds from N.E. steering S.E. all sail out & 6 shortened sail latter light winds with rain Remittura in sight Lat 22° 58'

Tuesday April 25th

First part of these 24 hours light winds from the S.E. steering with all sail out Middle part the same fine pleasant weather as best can wish for

Wednesday April 26th

First part of these 24 hours light Breeze from the S.E. raining weather Middle and latter part the same
