Thursday May 12th 1837 First part of these 24 hours fresh
breezes from the S. East laying off and on at 5 Capt came on board
on shore off Middle more moderate latter the same course by E
West Long by Chron 149° 05' Obsd Lat 16° 32' South

Friday May 13th First part of these 24 hours fine
breezes from S. E. steering by E at 6 O'clock took in sail heading E by E
Middle part fresh Sails from the S. E. & latter part made sail
course North with pleasant weather
West Long by Chron 149° 05' Obsd Lat 15° 39' South

Saturday May 20th First part of these 24 hours fine winds
from the S. E. steering North at 6 O'clock took in sail heading
South latter part wore ship to the S. E. & at 9 O'clock saw whales
lowered and struck to all 4 boats
West Long by Chron 149° 12' Obsd Lat 15° 22' South

Sunday May 21th 1834 First part of these 24 hours fine
weather took 1 to the Starboard & to the water boat &
to the bow boat alongside the ship Middle part the
same at daylight commenced cutting finished at noon
put the Birmingham in stores Long by Chron 149° 10' Lat Obs 15° 12' South

Monday May 22nd First part of these 24 hours fine weather
commenced Working Middle part the same took in sail
latter part steering by the wind at E
West Long by Chron 149° 11' Lat Obs 15° 09' South

Tuesday May 23rd First part of these 24 hours fine finished
Working at 6 took in sail heading South Middle part finished
and hoisted up Decks latter part made sail the S. by E
West Long by Chron 149° 11' Lat Obs 15° 09' South
