

Remarks On Board Ship Dartmouth

Wednesday 4th July First part of these 24 hours fine saw nothing Middle and latter parts the same saw a ship nothing remarkable spoke Sanges of Bristol 450th Oil

Thursday 5th July First part of these 24 hours fine stood in to the Bay of Fundy and hung with the Sanges and came to anchor at 4 o'clock S. & S. E. wind of the

Friday 6th July First part of these 24 hours fine all hands employed in mending and watering for 11 days I Walker & J Rowell discharged ship's men

Saturday 7th July First part of these 24 hours took our anchor and went to sea with a head wind got clear after tacking 30 times

Sunday 8th July First part of these 24 hours strong trades Middle and latter parts the same stood off and went round to the North side Capt went on shore

Monday 9th July First part of these 24 hours strong trades discharged Harry Earl boat came off Capt on shore & 6 stood off under double reefed Top Sails & 4 stood in 1 ship in sight

Tuesday 10th July First part of these 24 hours strong trades Middle & latter parts. More Moderate stood off & on saw nothing Lat 14° 08'

Wednesday 11th July First part of these 24 hours fine stood in Capt came on Board and stood off to the West Middle & latter parts Moderate

Lat 14° 24' Long 41° 27'

Thursday 22nd July First part of these 24 hours fine steering off West & 6 took in Sail heading to the North & 16 were ship daylight men for 1700

Friday 23rd July First part of these 24 hours fine boat went on shore at 8 and the Siskind a night came off Doubled reefed the Top Sails and stood off shore at Daylight stood in and tacked off again steering South Lat 14° 39'

Saturday 24th July First part of these 24 hours strong Trades steering South under Double Reef Top Sails Middle stood in saw the land Lat 14° 34'

Sunday 25th July First part of these 24 hours strong Trades stood off shore & 6 took in Sail heading South Middle part the same latter part stood in Lat 14° 22'

Monday 26th July First part of these 24 hours fine stood in saw the Siskind Capt Glasgow 1500th on shore out and Sanges a night single reefed Top Sails and stood off latter stood in boat went on shore

Tuesday 27th July First part of these 24 hours fine took a boat and Yams off and went in again Middle and latter parts Moderate got agams and 6000 nets

Wednesday 28th July First part of these 24 hours fine a night Capt came on Board and stood off Middle part fine weather latter part stood in with the Sanges and James Munroe

Thursday 29th July First part of these 24 hours fine in company with the Siskind & 6 came on squally with rain stood off shore under Double Reef Top Sails Middle and latter part fine strong winds kept on shore
