Tuesday 15th August First part of these 24 hours fine weather Middle and latter part the same saw jaspers nothing more remarkable
Long 171°50 Lat 14°13

134 Wednesday 16th August First part of these 24 hours good weather Middle under Doubtful
Sail latter saw a large whale lowered without success
Long 173°10 Lat 13°55

Thursday 17th August First part of these 24 hours strong Trades spoke the Mary Middle and latter part strong winds Long 172°23 Lat 13°34

Friday 18th August First part of these 24 hours strong Trades Middle and latter part squally with rain Long 172°06 Lat 13°36

Saturday 19th Aug First part of these 24 hours strong trades and rainy no sail out Middle and latter part fine weather nothing in sight Lat 13°16

Sunday 20th First part of these 24 hours fine weather Middle and latter part moderate breeze S E
Long 171°23 Lat 13°31 South

Monday 21st First part fine moderate weather no fish at sun down took in sail Middle the same latter part strong winds Lat 13°46 Long 170°41

134 Tuesday 22^d First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S E made Savage I bearing E S E distant 20 miles spoke the S P Tallridge of Folkestone 350 whale 250 upon 13 months out at 6 months - sail to the S W at daylight made sail & saw a large whale lowered without success

Thursday 24 First part of these 24 hours fine steering South at night took in sail to the S W Middle and latter part light winds steering S W by W
etc etc

Friday 25th First part of these 24 hours calm with rain & 6 took in sail to the S W by W Middle and latter part a heavy swell
Long by Lunar 170°15 Long by Chron 170°34 Lat 20°35

Saturday 26th First part of these 24 hours fine Breeze from E S E & 6 took in sail heading S S W Middle and latter part moderate steering South

Sunday 27th First part of these 24 hours light winds from the S steering South with rain Middle and latter part the same no sail out
etc etc

Monday 28th First part of these 24 hours rain no sail out Middle and latter part strong Breeze steering S by E
etc etc

Tuesday 29th First part of these 24 hours steering S by Middle steering S W. Savage Island bearing E S W Middle part heading S W latter part spoke the Sir Wm Wallace of Lundy 1400 lbs 18 months were ship to the North

Wednesday 30th First part of these 24 hours strong winds steering S W by W Middle have two latter part squally

Thursday 31st First part of these 24 hours strong winds Middle part the same latter part made sail steering South, ship in sight
