

Remarks On Board Ship Dartmouth Sn

Saturday 16th Sept First part of these 24 hours strong winds steering to the East & took in sail middle and latter part strong winds under double reef saw Finbacks
Long 173° 17' Lat 21° 54' South

Sunday 17th Sept First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the South Middle took in sail latter steering S.W. saw Finbacks and sail Long 173° 19' Lat 21° 15'

Monday 18th Sept First part of these 24 hours strong winds from East steering S.W. Middle took in sail Middle and latter part fine steering to the West
Long 174° 06' Lat 21° 57'

Tuesday 19th Sept First part of these 24 hours fine saw a ship take a whale & 2 small whales lowered and took one to the Harbour Boat and a 9 took her alongside and took in sail latter commenced cutting & 12 finished Long 173° 05' Lat 21° 36'

Wednesday 20th Sept First part of these 24 hours spoke 3rd murre cutting & 2 commenced striking middle and latter part fine S.W. in sight finished striking
Lat 21° 43' South

Thursday 21st Sept First part of these 24 hours fine steering to the West Middle and latter part fine steering to the South Long 173° 33' Lat 21° 24' South

Friday 22nd Sept First part of these 24 hours fine saw Blackfish steering to the South & took in sail Middle and latter part moderate & ship in sight
Long 173° 36' Lat 21° 50' South

Saturday 23rd Sept First part of these 24 hours steering West & took in sail Middle and latter part thick with strong winds steering S.W.
Long 178° 24' Lat 21° 41' South

Sunday 24th Sept First part of these 24 hours strong winds from the S.W. here too under close reefed main & fore sail heading S.W. Middle and latter part rainy

Monday 25th Sept First part of these 24 hours a gale from the East under close reefed main & fore sail Middle and latter part the same Long 173° 33' Lat 21° 49' South

Tuesday 26th First part of these 24 hours a gale Middle and latter part the same no sail out
Long 173° 53' Lat 21° 48'

Wednesday 27th First part of these 24 hours more moderate set the fore sail & sundown took in middle and latter part of these 24 hours moderate set the fore topsail and four sail
Long 173° 55' Lat 21° 50'

Thursday 28th Begins with fine breezes from the East heading S.W. by the wind under second sail at 6 P.M. wore ship to Westward and shortened sail for the night latter part rainy Lat 22° 25'

Friday 29th First part of these 24 hours rainy no sail set heading S.E. Middle very rainy latter more moderate all sail out steering to the S.W. Long 173° 45' Lat 22° 13'

Saturday 30th First part of these 24 hours moderate but foggy steering to the S.W. Middle took in sail latter part all sail out steering S.W. Long 173° 53' Lat 21° 46'

Sunday 1st October First part of these 24 hours light winds steering S.W. by S.W. & took in sail to the South Middle calm latter more S.W. to the South
Lat 21° 14' South
