Remarks On Board Ship Dartmouth In

Monday 18th Oct 1833

First part of these 24 hours rainy cold down spoke Rambler
Mantucket 35 months out 1700th x saw 6 sail & 6 took in sail
Heading to the South & commenced working latter part fine
Obs this day

Tuesday 19th Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine & 6 finished working saw 2 ship
& 6 took in Fore sail Heading to the East middle rainy latter part
fine steering to the S.W. saw 1 ship

Long by Chron 175° 28' West Lat by Obs 32° 54' South

Wednesday 20th Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine winds from S.E. steering North & 6 took in
sail Heading S.E. middle and latter part the same & daylight
commenced towing down 3 ship in sight

Lat by Obs 32° 17'

Thursday 21st Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine with strong winds & 6 finished
steering down worn ship to the South middle and latter strong
winds from the S.E. shaded ship

Long by Chron 176° 45' West Lat by Obs 32° 11' South

Friday 22nd Oct

First part of these 24 hours strong winds under doubled reefed topsails
spoke ship Elizabeth of Salem Capt Hedge & 6 took in sail
Heading to the South middle & latter part strong winds steering to the S.E.
the E in sight Long by Chron 174° 31' W Lat by Obs 31° 45'

Saturday 23rd Oct

First part of these 24 hours strong winds steering to the S.E. & 6 more
ship to the South and took in sail middle and latter strong winds from
the S.E. heading to the S.E. Long 175° 10' W Lat 32° 13' South

Sunday 24th Oct

First part of these 24 hours strong winds & 6 took in sail Heading
to the S.E. middle and latter to the South under closed reefed main
topsail blowing fresh from the East

Lat by Obs 32° 35' South

main topsail more ship to the S.E. at 10 more ship to the S.E. middle

steering to the S.E. wind hauled to the S.W. middle blowing heavy
latter more moderate with a heavy swell steering S.E. by E

Long by Chron 173° 58' W Lat 33° 42' South

Wednesday 25th Oct

First part of these 24 hours moderate set the Fore and Fore Top Sails
steering S.E. by E & 6 closed reefed main topsail course S by South
middle and latter strong winds and a heavy swell course East

Long 172° 35' West Lat by Obs 34° 25'

Thursday 26th Oct

First part of these 24 hours strong wind a heavy sea course East & 6
under closed reefed main topsail Heading S.W. middle and latter strong
winds from the S.W. heading S.E. Long 172° 38' Lat 34° 24' S

Friday 27th Oct

First part of these 24 hours strong winds heavy swell laying too to the
S.E. middle and latter part moderate under doubled reefed topsails
steering to the S by W Lat 34° 24'

Saturday 28th Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine weather winds from S.E. steering
to the S.W. & 6 took in sail middle and latter part fine
weather steering to the S.W. Long 173° 54' W Lat 34° 47' South

Sunday 29th Oct

First part of these 24 hours all sail out course S.W. & 6 more ship
to the East and took in sail middle and latter fine weather
steering to the S.W. Long 174° 23' W Lat 25° 16' South

Monday 30th Oct

First part of these 24 hours fine strong Trades steering to the South
& 6 took in sail saw a grampse middle strong winds & made sail
and two whales chased them without success they going quick
took up the boats and made all sail for them
