Long by Lunar 160° 52' E Long by Chron 160° 18' East Lat 25° 23' South
First time Chron. varying from Thursday 14th

First part of these 24 hours fine steering the N.E. & winds from the E. & sundown shortened sail and wore ship to the S.W. Middle part fine latter the same all sail out in company with R
Long by Lunar 160° 48' E Long by Chron 161° 54' E Lat 26° 00'
Friday 15th

First part of these 24 hours fine weather tacked ship to the North & sundown took in sail Middle part fine latter part made sail in company with the Richmond saw plenty of Finbacks
Long by Chron 160° 15' East Lat 25° 20' South
Saturday 16th

First part of these 24 hours cloudy winds from the N.E. & took in sail and set the spencers to the East Middle part heavy rain storm latter Toss winds under Doubled
Long by Chron 160° 10' East Lat 25° 51' South
Sunday 17th

First part of these 24 hours cloudy weather under Doubled Reep & night wind hauled to the S.W. & took in sail to S.W. wind hauled to the N.E. & laying to the East & daylight under sail Doubled Reep to the S.W. & some rain
Long by Lunar 160° 34' East by Chron 161° 15' E Lat 26° 44' South
Monday 18th

First part of these 24 hours fine by spells winds N.E. & course E.S.E. & sundown took in sail to the East Middle and latter part light winds with squalls of rain steering to the N.E. &
No ill this day
Tuesday 19th

First part of these 24 hours fine winds from the W steering to the N.E. & sundown took in sail to the North Middle part winds from the S.W. steering East latter part rainy under Doubled Reep Main Top sail course N.E. Lat 26° 56' South

Coast New Holland

Wednesday 20th June

First part of these 24 hours cloudy & 3 saw humpbacks & sundown hauled by the wind to the East Middle part fine & daylight made all sail to the N.E. & winds from the East
Long by Lunar Chron 162° 11' East 35 miles to add 60 Lat 26° 00' South
Thursday 21st June

First part of these 24 hours fine all sail out steering by the wind to the North & sundown tacked ship to the S.E. and took in sail Middle part and latter about the same
Long by Chron 162° 03' East without correction
Friday 22nd June

First part of these 24 hours fine weather winds N.E. with Larboard Jacks & sundown took in sail to the S.W. Middle part fine & daylight under double Reep Top sail course S.E. by E took down the Main stay and stripped it and fitted it and sent it up again
Lat 26° 34'



Saturday 23rd

First part of these 24 hours fine weather got through with the stay and sent it up saw Finbacks course S.E. by E Middle part under short sail course E.S.E. Middle and latter part fine weather course East wind West plenty of Humpbacks and Finbacks in sight
Long by Chron 164° 17' East Sunday 24th Lat 26° 54'

First part of these 24 hours fine weather winds South course East & sundown Doubled Reeped and hauled to the S.E. Middle part strong winds latter part the same with Main sail and jib out course E by N Long 166° 40' East Lat 27° 03' South
Monday 25th

First part of these 24 hours more moderate with a heavy swell course E by N under Doubled Reep & sundown took in Mainsail and jib Middle and latter part almost calm with a very heavy swell from the North Long by Lunar 167° 13' East Chron 166° 56' Lat 26° 33' South
Tuesday 26th

First part of these 24 hours heavy swell Borealis bearing S.E. by S 1/4 South course S.E. by E winds N.E. & sundown Doubled Reeped on our course saw Finbacks Middle and latter a gale from the North with a heavy sea under Double Reeped Top sail course East
Long by Lunar 170° 13' East by Chron 169° 22' East Lat 26° 12' South
